



## Track Rules (3/14/26)

These rules will be strictly enforced. If you are stopped for breaking ANY of these rules you may be asked to leave for the day and will not receive a refund. Please help keep Canaan Lions MX a safe place to ride!

### Waiver Requirements

- ANY PERSON ENTERING THE PIT must sign in acknowledging they are releasing liability and know the track rules prior to entering the pit area. EVERYONE MUST SIGN IN
- Any racer under the age of 18 MUST have a minor waiver on file for the current season. **Friend's parents or other relatives may not sign minor waivers so plan ahead (if a parent will not be at the race, a parent MUST sign the waiver and the parental permission for temporary guardianship of minor in front of a notary prior to arrival at the track).**
- Any spectator under the age of 18 MUST have a parent/guardian sign the spectator waiver and track rules waiver upon entrance to the track, if a parent will not be present the waiver must be signed and notarized prior to entrance to the track.
- All racers/mechanics/parents of Stacyc and 50cc bikes must sign a racer waiver.
- All closed gates must remain closed. Please do not open closed gates.
- No smoking or vaping outside of your camping/parking site.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> offense is a warning
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> offense you will be asked to leave the property for the day and incur a 1 race ban
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> offense you will incur a 1-year ban
- NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY.
  - Possession within fenced-in areas (track, infield, starting gate, mechanics area) = 1-year ban or longer.
- Abuse of Any Kind (Physical, Mental, Verbal) toward another person (including staff, volunteers and other riders) WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
  - Minimum punishment will be a 4-race ban of you and/or the rider you are there to watch.
  - Maximum punishment will be a lifetime ban and the potential of criminal penalties.
- No glass containers/bottles allowed on the premises.
- Dispute Resolution:
  - Any of the three co-chairs (Tyler Paul, Matthew Tucker, or Melissa Underhill)
  - If you cannot find one of these three, CALMLY go to the tower for assistance.
- No cutting the track.

- No stopping on the track or pulling off to the side. Please exit if there is an issue.
- No spectators on the track at any time.
  - Parents/Guardians/Coaches must use the staging area by the scoring tower.
    - The only exceptions are parents of the Stacyc and 50cc class riders (1 parent per racer), who may enter the track with the appropriate wristband visible to the track personnel.
  - Mechanic Regulations:
    - Only mechanics with a wristband (\$2 fee and must be 18 or older) are allowed in the starting gate and mechanics areas.
  - Breaking this rule may result in immediate disqualification of rider, ejection from the track, and/or denial of entry to the track in the future.
- All riders must enter and exit the track using the proper entrances and exits only.
- All riders must wear a helmet, goggles, and protective gear at all times. Helmets must be worn at all times.
- No sneakers/shorts/tank tops. Long sleeves and all safety requirements are a must.
- There are NO motorized/electric bike riding in the pit area on race days.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times.
- No wheelies in the pit area ever.
- SPEED LIMIT: 5 MPH in the pits at all times (cars, trucks, bikes etc.,).
- FLAGS ON THE TRACK:
  - YELLOW FLAG – Rider down – proceed with caution. No jumping.
  - YELLOW FLAG AND RED CROSS FLAG - Emergency personnel are on the track - proceed with caution. No jumping, no passing, be prepared to stop.
  - BLACK FLAG – Single rider must stop immediately.
  - RED FLAG – On track emergency! ALL riders must exit the track immediately. No jumping.
